This is a gravity-feed system with a holding tank. From the source to the holding tank there exists 920 feet of one-inch pipe. The holding tank is approximately 400 gallons. From the holding tank to the farmsite there is an additional 500 feet of 3/4 inch pipe.

Befpre his death, Mr. Payne sold the farmsite to me. Since it
was built in the thirties, the farmsite has been served by this
small spring. Southcoast lumber has suggested that I make this
application for water rights.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 19, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 28, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19...79

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19...80
