The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed creek. The use to which this water is to be applied is \_\_\_\_\_irrigation If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_1/80th \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The priority date of this permit is May 5, 1977 Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 12, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979....
