1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream and Res. from Farmers Creek, a tributary of Nestucca River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 910 ft. S and 2070 ft. E from the NW corner of SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1

both being within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. 4S, R. 10W, W. M., in the county of Tillamook

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the

stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream and five rearing ponds to be constructed under application No. R 55605, permit No. R 6647. Water to be diverted from unnamed stream when available with any deficiency in the available supply from unnamed stream to be made up by appropriation from Farmers Creek, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.50 c.f.s.

The use to which this water is to be applied is fish culture

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 4, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 4, 1978 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979
