DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Beginnig 50 ft. north of the S.W. corner of lot #12 in Block V, Lake of the Woods, 1 1/2 plastic line(80 lb pressure per Sq. inch) buried 1 ft deep, extending in a westerly direction, 325 ft to the waters edge of the lake and then 100 ft out into the lake with a foot valve attached with a screened basket around the foot valve. The water Pump is to be a Berkley Jet, Elect. ~~2000~~ 1/2 H.P., located 150' west of point of beginning. The power source will be 110 volt AC from our cabin on Lot #12, carried thru 10-2 UF underground cable, to be buried 12" deep along side of water line to pump. Pump box to be 3ft sq, flush with ground, well ventilated, drainage and with a metal cover, pad locked. Pump box floor to be concrete.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Lake of the Woods

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for 2 families

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 23, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 4, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
