## **Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon**

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:*

*The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed ..... 0.01..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from .....spring.....and.....South.....Umpqua.....River with water to be diverted from spring when available with any deficiency in the .....in the available supply from the spring to be made up by appropriation from South.....Umpqua.....River, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall.....not exceed 0.01 c.f.s.*

The use to which this water is to be applied is..... domestic use for 2 families including  
the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre in area for each family.

*If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... of one cubic foot per second  
or its equivalent for each acre irrigated .....*

*and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

*The priority date of this permit is May 23, 1977, for the spring, and July 15, 1977, for South Umpqua River*

Actual construction work shall begin on or before..... November 4, 1978..... and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979.....

*Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19.....* 80
