1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Gales Creek with any deficiency made up from an unnamed stream and Pond(s)...., a tributary of Tualatin River
 from Gales Creek
2. The point of diversion is to be located 1,890 ft. S and 170 ft. E
 (N. or S.) (E. or W.)
 from the NW corner of S. Shepherd D. L. C. No. 62
 (Public Land Survey Corner)
 The point of diversion from Pond No. 1 is to be located 1,670 ft. S and 810 ft. E
 (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)
 from the NW corner of S. Shepard D.L.C. No. 62. The point of diversion from Pond No. 2 is to be located 1,200 ft. S and 470 ft. E from the NW corner of S. Shepard D.L.C. No. 62. being within the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Sec. 17 Tp. 1N R. 4W W. M., in the county of....Washington.....

supplemental irrigation (Howell Pond).

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Water will be pumped from Gales Creek through a 6 inch polyvinyl chloride pipeline to Howell Pond.

The proposed pump will be a centrifugal pump powered by a 10 H. P. electric motor.

7. Construction work will begin on or before Construction has commenced

8. Construction work will be completed on or before August 15, 1977

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before June 1, 1978

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Remarks: This is a new application for the appropriation of water for irrigation of lands previously not irrigated. The land is presently in brush but will be cleared this summer (1977) or fall.

Water will be pumped from Gales Creek to Howell Pond and then to the lands for irrigation. Stored winter runoff in Howell Pond will be used for supplemental irrigation.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.51 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Gales Creek, unnamed streams and ponds to be constructed under application No. R 56386, permit No. R 6676.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation, provided that no water shall

be diverted from direct flow of the streams during the period from July 31 through

September 15 of each year.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs to be constructed under permit No. R 6676.


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 10, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 14, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
