Application for Permit to Appropriate Surface Water

I, Edmond D. Daige (Name of Applicant) of Rt 1 - Box 14, Riddle (Mailing Address), Riddle (City), Oregon 97469 (Zip Code), Phone No. 874-2985 do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cow Creek, a tributary of S. Umpqua River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 370 ft. N. and 580 ft. E. from the NW corner of Catching D.L.C. 40 (Public Land Survey Corner)

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Cow Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is stock

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 1, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 14, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
