make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream, a tributary of Rock Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1405 ft. N and 1565 ft. W from the center corner of Sec. 1

being within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 1 Tp. 26S R. 3W, W.M., in the county of Douglas

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

Approx 8" dam; 2" plastic pipe to first 4'x4'x3' high wood box. Then another 2" plastic pipe to second 4'x4'x3' box. Then 2" plastic pipe the distance to house. Gravity flow; no pump. Irrigation will be done with 3/4" sections off of main line where needed for livestock and garden.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.255 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.25 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 24, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 14, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Extended to Oct. 1 1980 Extended to Oct. 1 1981 Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
