The points of diversion are to be located 60 feet south & 650 feet east from the NW corner of Section 17, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T. 13 S., R. 28 E., W.M.; 440 feet south & 860 feet west from the NE corner of Section 17, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T. 13 S., R. 28 E., W.M.; 1700 feet north & 770 feet west from the SE corner of Section 16, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 13 S., R. 28 E., W.M., in the county of Grant.

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Remarks: Cert. 2801 allows the use of 1/80th cfs/ acre. This is not sufficient when flood irrigation is used on these lands, thus I am requesting an additional 1/80th cfs/ acre for those lands covered by cert. 2801. I am also applying for 1/40th cfs/ acre on those lands presently irrigated but not covered by any right from the river.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.4 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from John Day River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 4, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
