make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cooley Creek and Claussen Reservoir, a tributary of Willamette River (coast Fork)

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1150 ft. N. and 1900 ft. W.

from the SE corner of Sec. 4, T. 21S., R. 3W. diversion is by pipe from stream to reservoir, the diversion dam is located in the SW/4/SE/4 of sec. 4.

being within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 21S., R. 3W., W. M., in the county of Lane.

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Cooley Creek and Claussen Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R 56229, permit No. R6690

The use to which this water is to be applied is fish culture and stock; being 0.005 c.f.s. for fish culture and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 18, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 19, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
