make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Clackamas River, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 50 ft. North and 400 ft. West from the SE corner of Section 11, (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 11 Tp. 2 S R. 2 E, W. M., in the county of Clackamas (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is Centrifugal pump with electric motor at

river pumping through a burried 6 inch line to the irrigated land and then

through a portable sprinkler system in the irrigated field.

7. Construction work will begin on or before Summer of 1977

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Fall of 1977

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Fall of 1978

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Remarks: The lands above described also have a right for irrigation from ground water under certificate No. 28162. In the interests of conserving groundwater it is intended to use water from the Clackamas River to the extent available and use from the well to make up any lack of water from the river.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clackamas River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 2 1/2 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply, provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources does not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 20, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 19, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
