Application for Permit to Appropriate Surface Water

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 480 ft. S and 2430 ft. W from the NE corner of Sec. 21

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 26 S, R. 5 W, W. M., in the county of Douglas

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 29, 1977, for irrigation, November 29, 1977, for domestic use.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 19, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
