issued to Jesse and Florence A. Ott on April 29, 1955, and Permit No. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

24294 issued to School District 9-C on December 21, 1956. 8 residences, domestic use only 0.01 CFS; 1 grocery store & station .05 CFS; yard & garden .05 CFS

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is distribution to domestic users supplied

by Allegany District Improvement Company, an Oregon corporation: 9 domestic including church and 8 irrigation of one acre or less and 1 commercial.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A 40" wooden dam with a 1" plastic pipe running into a well tile in the center of a 20' x 24' pond, thence through a 1" pipe to a 5000 gal. redwood reservoir tank, thence through a 1-1/2" plastic pipe for distribution to eight residences, a community church, and a country grocery store, all as is more particularly described in the attached copy of Articles of Incorporation of the Allegany District Improvement Company. Irrigation will include only flowers, lawns, and individual household vegetable gardens, none of which exceeds one-half (1/2) acre in size. 8 residences (domestic use only) 0.01 CFS; 1 small grocery store and filling station with radiator water hose .05 CFS; 8 residences, yard and garden irrigation .05 CFS

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for 8 families, commercial use in church, store and gas station, and irrigation, being 0.03 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.01 c.f.s. for commercial use and 0.05 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 21, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 19, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
