make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Gribble Creek Channel and  
reservoir, a tributary of Molalla river

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1750 ft. S and 1050 ft. E  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
from the N.W. corner of Sec 21  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of  
Sec. 21 Tp. 4S R. 1E, W.M., in the county of Clackamas  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation. D.N.A.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cfs from Griddle Creek and 0.70 acre feet from reservoir cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is to fill and keep filled a dam, reservoir for fish culture.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

This is an excavated sump with earthfill banks 2' 3" above natural ground. Maximum height will be 2.0 above ground surface. Top width will be 6.0 feet, slope 2:1 slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line is 2.5 feet.

7. Construction work will begin on or before complete

8. Construction work will be completed on or before complete

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before reservoir full.

### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:*

*The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Gribble Creek and Channel Cat Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R 56371, permit No. R 6696,*

*The use to which this water is to be applied is fish culture,*

*If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.....*


*and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*
