1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNNAMED CREEK

AND RESERVOIR, a tributary of HOOD RIVER

2. The point of diversion is to be located 462 ft. N and 846 ft. E

from the S 1/4 corner of SECTION 15
(Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A 2" INTAKE PIPE THROUGH THE DAM SUPPLIES WATER TO A 3 hp GE MOTOR AND CENTRIFICAL PUMP WHICH SUPPLIES PRESENT PORTABLE IRRIGATION SYSTEM. IRRIGATION SYSTEM WILL BE CONNECTED BY 160 FEET OF BURIED 4" PVC STOCK TO BE WATERED OUT OF THE SHALLOW (SOUTH) PART OF RESEVOIR.

7. Construction work will begin on or before UPON APPROVAL OF PERMIT

8. Construction work will be completed on or before 90 DAYS AFTER APPROVAL

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before 10-1-1980

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

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This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.175 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R 56795, permit No. R 6702.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation, supplemental irrigation and stock; being 0.17 c.f.s. for irrigation and supplemental irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R 6702, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 10, 1977, for 0.065 c.f.s., and October 25, 1977, for 0.11 c.f.s.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 4, 1979 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
