Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Spring Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Permittee is hereby put on notice that, because this permit is junior in priority to all other rights on the Klamath River, existing before the date of application No. 56023, and that the water available might be less than the amount stated herein if runoff in the Klamath River Basin is insufficient to satisfy all rights with senior priority, including those of the United States under its 1905 filings, the Klamath River Compact, or under the decree of a court of competent jurisdiction.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 6, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 4, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
