1. The source of the proposed appropriation is WOAHINK LAKE, a tributary of

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1200 ft. NORTH and 10 ft. WEST from the EAST 1/4 corner of SECTION 23, T19S, R12W, W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION WATER FOR ONE HALF ACRE OR LESS OF NON COMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

The pipeline for this system is approx. 2200 FT OF 1 1/2" P.V.C. pipe. The pump is a one (1) HP Submerged, 50' static head. All Rights of ways and permits have been secured. The pipe line tested and buried in a workman like manner. Ordinary garden and lawn sprinklers will be used for irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Woahink Lake

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 24, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 4, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
