DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

System will consist of a 50' x 100' x 8' fish pond (reservoir filing included) with inlet pipe from creek.....

Concrete and wood headgate.....

4 raceways for fish 8' wide by 4' deep, 125 to 150 ft in length, leading to a dry stream bed, through which water will be returned to Jumpoff Joe Creek; Main irrigation line will be 4" diameter by 1400' long, with two laterals 3" diameter by 320' long, irrigation will be by 14 rainbird sprinklers, each having 7 gpm capacity Supplied by a 7 H.P.

DRN electric Pump & Motor.

Water flow thru raceways is gravity flow.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Jumpoff Creek and McIntyre Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R 55636, permit No. R 6748, for irrigation and fish culture; being 0.20 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.23 c.f.s. for fish culture.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and fish culture.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R 6748.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 8, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 2, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
