Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring, with any deficiency in the available supply from the spring to be made up by diversion from South Fork of Little Butte Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for two families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area for one family.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 20, 1977, for South Fork Little Butte Creek, July 26, 1977, for the spring.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 2, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
