1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Drain Line  
a tributary of Pine Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 935 ft. S and 15 ft. W

from the N $\frac{1}{2}$  corner of Sec. 1, T. 8S, R. 45E W.M.  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

The drainage pipe will consist of 600' of buried 6" perforated plastic pipe and 400' of 4" buried plastic perforated pipe. The headgate will consist of concrete with one 6" opening with a slide gate. A pumping sump will be located just upstream from the headgate. The pump will be a Burkley centrifugal driven by P-TO. Sprinkler pipe will consist of 760' of 4" mainline and 840' of 3" lateral pipe.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a surface drain tile.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 4, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 1, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
