Point of Diversion No. 1:

The proposed point of diversion number 1 is located 2,055 feet west and 185 feet north from the S.E. corner of Section 21, within the S.W. quarter of the S.E. quarter of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 E.W.M., in the County of Umatilla. There is no name of a ditch to be used from the point of diversion.

Point of Diversion No. 2:

The proposed point of diversion number 2 is located 2,400 feet west and 1370 North from the S. E. corner of Section 21, being within the N.W. quarter of the S.E. quarter of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 E.W.M., in the County of Umatilla. There is no ditch to be used from the point of diversion.

Point of Diversion No. 3:

The proposed point of diversion number 3 is located 2,600 feet west and 1,860 feet north from the S.E. corner of Section 21, being within the N.W. quarter of the S.E. quarter of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 E.W.M., in the County of Umatilla. There is no ditch to be used from the point of diversion.

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Remarks: Applicant simultaneously is applying for change in places of use and points of diversion for existing water rights, consisting of 13.0 acres of existing water rights. Please refer simultaneously to that application. Applicant desires, after rearranging the existing water right, to acquire new surface water right for remaining acres, using the same points of diversion as requested in the other application.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from McKay Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 3, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 10, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
