make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is S. Fork Little Butte Creek and Hillcrest Reservoir, a tributary of Little Butte Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 600 ft. S and 525 ft. W from the E1/4 corner of Sec. 29 being within the NE1/4 of the SE1/4 (Public Land Survey Corner)

of Sec. 29 Twp. 36S R. 2E, W.M. (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

Reservoir is located 200' S and 1200' W from the E1/4 corner of Sec. 21

being within the NE1/4 SE 1/4 and NW1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 21 Tp. 37 S R. 1 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Fork Little Butte Creek and Hillcrest Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R56530, permit No. R 6774.

The use to which this water is to be applied is temperature control.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control on forms furnished.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 30, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 10, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
