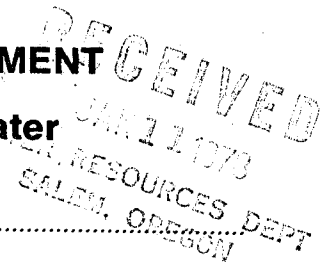

make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is John Day Pool - Columbia River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1730 ft. N and 200 ft. W from the SW corner of Sec. 17 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 17 Tp. 5N R. 28E, W. M., in the county of Umatilla

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 37.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Columbia River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 11, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
