1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNNAMED STREAM for POD #1 x
UNNAMED STREAM for POD #2, a tributary of CATCHING Slough

2. The point of diversion is to be located #1 850' S and #1 680'
#2 1160' ft. (N. or S.) and #2 1075' ft. (E. or W.)
from the N¹/₄ corner of Sec. 20
(Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Sec. 20 Tp. 26 S R. 12 W, W. M., in the county of COOS
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

POD #1 (AS SHOWN ON ATTACHED MAP) TO COLLECT WATER. A $\frac{3}{4}$ "
HP ELECTRIC PUMP ADJACENT TO CASINGS PUMPS THE WATER
FROM CASINGS TO THE HOUSE, A DISTANCE OF APPROX. 200', THROUGH
A $\frac{3}{4}$ " PIPE.

POD #2 WOULD BE USED TO SUPPLEMENT POD #1 IF IT BECOMES
DEFICIENT. PRESENTLY, THE POND BELOW POD #2 IS USED
BY APPLICANT TO RAISE TROUT AS A HOBBY AND WOULD ALSO
BE USED FOR FIGHTING FIRE IN AN EMERGENCY

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream #1, with any deficiency in the available supply from stream #1 to be made up by diversion from unnamed stream #2.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 4, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
