DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

POD #2 & POD #1 are both in use at the present.
POD #2 consists of 1-500 gal metal tank served by 50' of 1" plastic
pipe impounded in spring source. Outfall is by a combination of
1 1/4" & 1" plastic pipe to existing house and garden spot.
POD #1 consists of 1200 gal plastic tank supplied by 50' of 1 1/4"
plastic pipe. Outfall is by 1 1/2" & 1" plastic pipe to existing house
and garden spot. Both systems are independent but are
cross connected at house with a series of valves.
Both systems are gravity. No pumps are in use.

If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied TWO

7. Construction work will begin on or before 03-02-79
8. Construction work will be completed on or before 03-02-81
9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before 05-01-81

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Remarks: Both sources are fed by seepage from springs from the steep terrain with any excess running through our property and into Kentucky Creek.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream #1, with any deficiency in the available supply from unnamed stream #1 to be made up by diversion from unnamed stream #2.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for two families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre for each family.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 6, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 3, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
