make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of CANAL CREEK

2. The point of diversion is to be located 75 ft. S (N. or S.) and 1000 ft. E (E. or W.) from the SW corner of US LOT 7 OF SEC. 32, TOWNSHIP 13S, RANGE 10W OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, IN LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 32 Tp. 13S (N. or S.) R. 10W (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of LINCOLN

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

LAWN AND GARDEN

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WILL CONSIST OF A SUBMERSIBLE
ELECTRICAL PUMP, WHICH IS 1 hp. 17 STAGE 220 VOLT
FAIRBANKS MORSE BRAND. PUMP IS DESIGNED TO PUMP
APPROXIMATELY 6 GALLONS PER MINUTE. WATER WILL BE
PUMP TO AN EIGHTY-TWO GALLON METAL STORAGE TANK (de-
signed to withstand a maximum of ONE HUNDRED AND
FIFTY POUNDS), at a hundred lbs. pressure. IN DISCUS-
SION WITH PUMP DEALER, THIS WAS THE PRESURE NEEDED TO GET
WATER TO HOUSE LOCATION. ~~FROM THE STORAGE~~ THE STOR-
AGE TANK IS 25' EAST OF DIVERSION AND WILL BE ENCLOSED IN
METAL BUILDING. FROM THE STORAGE TANK IS 450 FEET
OF 1" P.V.C. PIPE RUNNING ~~45~~ N.W. TO HOUSE AND GARDEN
AREA. TWO TEEL MODEL IP656 WATER FILTERS WILL BE
IN LINE BETWEEN STORAGE TANK AND HOUSE. IRRIGATION
WILL PROBABLY BE OVER HEAD SPRINKLING AND GRAVITY FLOW
DITCHING, ALL WHICH WILL COME ^{from} TWO SEPERATE 3/4" SPIKITS.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and irrigation of 1/2 acre non-commercial lawn and garden; being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use, and 0.005 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 8, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 3, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
