make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a reservoir

at the intersection of...

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1270 ft. North and 1270 ft. East (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

from the Southwest corner of Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 20 East, Willamette Meridian (Public Land Survey Corner)

Range 20 East, Willamette Meridian

being within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 25 Tp. 10 S R. 20 E, W. M., in the county of Wheeler (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

6. **DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

*Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.*

The water is to be diverted from Bear Creek, into a ditch of the following dimensions: three foot bottom width, 1:1 side slopes and a 2.5 ft. minimum depth. The ditch carries the water approximately 4100' where it passes under a road and into the Mitchell Ranch Reservoir, owned by Brooks Resources.

When necessary, the water can be pumped back by a 20 hp. pump through a six-inch line and can be used for sprinkler and/or flood irrigation.

7. Construction work will begin on or before May 1, 1978

8. Construction work will be completed on or before July 1, 1978

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before August 15, 1978

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Remarks: According to an agreement with Brooks Resources, the applicant will furnish a diversion right of way to be used for filling Mitchell Ranch Reservoir. In return, Brooks Resources will store spring, fall and winter flow for the applicant to use as a supplement to water secured under Certificate No. 10948, Permit No. 6178

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30.0 a.f. of stored water only measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-7015.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 4.0 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 13, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 5, 1979 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Extended to Oct. 1 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
