THE WATER IS COLLECTED NEAR PROPERTY LINE BY SMALL CONCRETE DAM 2 1/2 FT ACROSS 1 FT HIGH. TRAVELS APPROXIMATELY 150 FT THROUGH 1 1/2 INCH PIPE TO HOLDING TANK CONSTRUCTED OF WOOD 6 FT HIGH, 8 FT WIDE, 20 FT LONG. THE TANK IS COVERED WITH PUMP MOUNTED ON ROOF AND WATER IS THEN PUMPED THROUGH 1 INCH PIPE TO HOUSES AND SURROUNDING AREAS.

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Remarks: THIS WATER SYSTEM HAS BEEN IN USE SINCE BEFORE THE 1930'S TO MY KNOWLEDGE. THE PRESENT HOME WAS BUILT BY BEN E. STONE IN LATE 1930'S. THE RENTAL WAS BUILT BEFORE OR SHORTLY AFTER 1900. THE SYSTEM WAS DAMAGED BY MUD SLIDE FROM NEIGHBOR'S PROPERTY, NECESSITATING THE REBUILDING OF DIVERSION DAM AND SUPPLY LINE. THE HOLDING TANK WAS NOT DAMAGED.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream.

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VIEW OREGON WATER RESOURCES DIVISION JUL 11 1978

The use to which this water is to be applied is for domestic use for two families and irrigation; being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use, and 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 18, 1978, for 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation and domestic, and June 8, 1978 for 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 5, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981.
