6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Gladstone's Ranney Collector is located on the Clackamas River with horizontal collectors projected radially under the river bed. The concrete intake structure houses three pumps capable of producing 5.5 MGD. The current pumping capacity is approximately 4 cfs, limited by consumption demand and storage capacity. The distribution system consists of 700' of 16", 8000' of 24", 2200' of 12" and numerous 8", 6" and smaller pipe. Current storage capacity is 2.2 MG.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.73 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clackamas River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Municipal.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 28, 1978.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1979 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980. Extended to Oct. 1985 - Extended to October 1, 1990, 10-1-95, 10-1-2000

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981. Extended to Oct. 1985, Extended to October 1, 1990, 10-1-95, 10-1-2000
