cubic feet per second Wagner Lake - 1.97; Whittaker Lake - .57

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

.This application is intended to include all cropland acres on farm not now included in permit 21557. Diversions are the same as those used with permit 21557. Plan is to connect both diversions into a common buried pipeline. The pipe from Wagner Lake to E-W main hence to the west is already partially installed. The application designates easterly acres from Whittaker and westerly from Wagner. This division approximates the available water supply from each source. In practice a proportion of the water from each source will be randomly used across the total farm. Issuance of the permit/certificate on a proportionate rather than designated basis would be desired, if possible. System includes electric-driven centrifugal pumps, buried PVC mainline (eventually) and wheel roll and hand move lateral. Legal description of property should be available with application 27392, permit 21557.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.54 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Wagner Lake and Whittaker Lake; being 1.97 c.f.s. from Wagner Lake and 0.57 c.f.s. from Whittaker Lake.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer

The priority date of this permit is May 11, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
