1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed creek flowing across Lot 2502, SW 1/4, Sec. 31 Twp 36S, Range 6W M/M, Josephine Cty, a tributary of the Applegate River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1630 ft. N and 50 ft. E from the SW Corner corner of Sec 31, TWP 36 S, Range 6 W M/M

(N. or S.)

(Public Land Survey Corner)

said diversion from existing instream pond located within Lot 2502 via pond pump and pipe to 5.06 acres of Lot 2502 for irrigation by sprinklers. From the same point of diversion water to be piped to 5.08 acres of Lot 2503 for stock watering purposes.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

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The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and stock; being 0.25 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock watering.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 27, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
