1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Pine Creek

(Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Point of diversion and ditch already exist, will be using pipe from elevated ditch to gravity sprinkle lands shown.

7. Construction work will begin on or before June 30, 1979

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1980

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Oct. 1, 1981

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pine Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 5, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 16, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
