make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream and reservoir, a tributary of Chehalem River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1460 ft N and 1350 ft W from the SE corner of Section 3 (Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 3 Tp. 3S R. 3W, W. M., in the county of YAMHILL

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.065 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-57669, permit No. R-7666

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and stock; being 0.06 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 20, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 22, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
