1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Excavated reservoir filled from winter flooding of Beaver Creek, a tributary of Gales Creek

6. **DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

This will be an excavated reservoir 90' x 230' x 13' with 1½:1 side slopes. The water will be used to irrigate row crops, grain and hay. A 20 horse power electric pump will be used to pump water through a portable sprinkler system.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.7 acre feet of stored water only... measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-57706, permit No. R-7695.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to... of one cubic foot per second... a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 27, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 5, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Extended to Oct. 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
