make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is springs #1-#4 and unnamed stream from spring #5, a tributary of Pine Cr.

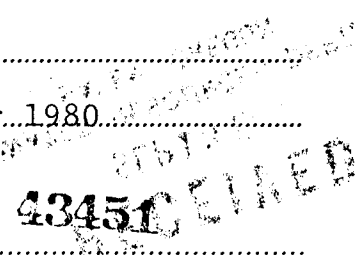



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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from four springs and an unnamed stream; being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring #1, 0.005 c.f.s. from spring #2, and 0.05 c.f.s. from spring #3, with any deficiency in the available supply from the three springs to be made up by an appropriation from spring #4 and the unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic for two families: being domestic for one family from spring #1, domestic from another family from spring #2; and irrigation from spring #3.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 13, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 5, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
