make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Wolf Creek, a tributary of Catching Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 120 ft. N and 200 ft. W from the SW corner of sec 35, T 29S, R 13 W, W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 35 Tp. 29S R. 13W, W.M., in the county of COOS

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is To grow trees in a nursery for reforestation purposes

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A dam will be constructed four (4) feet high and 15 feet long. A 4" plastic pipe will be used on the suction side of the pump.

The pump will be a 7 1/2 hp single phase electric pump.

The discharge side will be a 3" pipe.

Twenty rain bird type sprinklers will be used in the system.

It is 220 feet from the pump to where the first sprinkler head is located.

There will be 1200 feet of lateral pipe in the system.

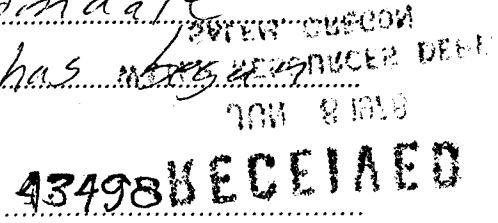

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Remarks: Moore Mill owns 53,000 acres of timberlands in Coos County and Douglas County. In order to be able to adequately reforest those acres it is necessary for us to operate our own nursery. This is due to the shortage of good quality seedlings for coastal plantations.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.72 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Wolf Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation of forest nursery and stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 8, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 5, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
