make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is ~~the~~ UNNAMED Stream, a tributary of Daniels Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located <sup>1320</sup>~~975~~ ft. N (N. or S.) and ~~115~~ ft. E (E. or W.) from the interior <sup>CENTER</sup> 1/4 corner of 35 (Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Natural sump in streambed is where foot valve will be located. Water to be pumped from stream to 1200 gal. holding tank and then pumped from tank to house in 1.5" PVC 200' line. Irrigation system will consist of garden hose and portable sprinklers for lawn. Pump has not been yet purchased but will likely be 1 to 1.5 H.P. pump.

Livestock will be watered from a round 100 gal watering tank.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for one family, stock, and irrigation, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.005 c.f.s. for stock, and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 4, 1978 for 0.013 c.f.s. and September 9, 1978 for 0.007 c.f.s.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 5, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
