1. The source of the proposed appropriation is P.O.D. #1 is Sixes River, tributary of Peethiuan, P.O.D. #2 Unnamed stream, a tributary of Sixes River.

2. The point of diversion is to be located ^{#1} 240 ft. N and 220 ft. W
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

P.O.D. #2 1220 ft N, 260 ft W. from interior corner of Sec 8

being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Sec. 8 Tp. 32 S R. 14 W, W. M., in the county of Curry

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

P.O.D. #1 25ft of 1 in pipe to Corold Balance-flow pump, 1/3 H.P. motor, discharge line 100ft 1 in pipe to mobile home with two hose-bibs in garden.

P.O.D. #2 will be 25ft of 1 in pipe to Corold balance flow pump, 1/3 H.P. motor, discharge 300ft to 500 gallon Red-wood storage tank for holding, with gravity flow to mobile home three 1 in pipe app 400ft. Alternate valve system to supplement P.O.D. #1

If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied one

7. Construction work will begin on or before 30 Aug 1978 (has begun)

8. Construction work will be completed on or before 30 Aug 1981

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before 30 Aug 1981

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Remarks: Attempt to drill well was made 5/7/78 by Bill Miller Well Drilling, Bandon, Or. Bedrock of serpentine was found at 6 ft and drilling cont'd to below river level with no success. Water well report was filed 5/20/78

Note: - Phone call 9/26/78 - Mrs Smith stated that the unnamed stream does not flow into Sixes River at times when the River flow is low or below minimum flow standards. The unnamed stream only reaches the river at winter flows. Yes

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Sixes River, with any deficiency in the available supply to be made up by an appropriation from an unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 21, 1978


Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 13, 1979 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Extended to Oct. 1 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
