6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

There is two springs about 60 ft apart.)ne has a 12000 gal cement covered storage tank built over the top Of it, the other one has a small dirt dam built , and is piped with a 1-1/2 in plastic pipe carrying a portion of the water into the cement cistern. Then it is taken from the cement cistern in a 2 in.. plastic pipe gravity flow 2300 ft. to a storage tank holding 15000 gal.

From this storage it is taken 1200 ft. gravity flow to the three houses that use the water. This pipe is 2 in. carrying the water to the houses, which are close together.

7. Construction work will begin on or before..... This water has been in continious for these houses since 1912 when the first pipe line was installed.

8. Construction work will be completed on or before.....

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before.....

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Remarks: The first pipe line was installed in 1912. The 15000 gal. storage tank and a new pipe line to the buildings was installed in 1933. A new line from the storage tank to the springs was installed in 1940. It has been in continuous use since 1912.

In May 1977 we sold the property with the springs on it, but reserved the right to the spring, and the easements to maintain the springs, the pipe line for continued use. I bought the buildings and land from the rest of the partners of Groner Walnut Co. so the easments and rights have all been assigned to me Milburn Ziegler

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for three families.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 18, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 7, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
