make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mendenhall Creek, a tributary of Illinois River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 160 ft S and 53 ft E from the NW corner of N 89° 14' 25" Sec. 7 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 7 Tp. 40S R. 8W, W.M., in the county of Josephine

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.5

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is for irrigation

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

The dam will be a stop log type with wings cut into the bank. It will be designed by the CSC. Gavity flow channelled through 4 inch PCU pipe to a pond located closer to the field will be used. Excess water will be channelled back to the creek via a bar ditch. From the pond the water will be pumped by a gas water pump to the site of needed water.

If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied.....

7. Construction work will begin on or before Aug 1, 1979

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Oct 1, 1980

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Oct 1, 1981

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Remarks: If we are to have any form of agriculture on this property, we must have water rights. There is no surface table water during most of the summer and after 2 dry wells, we believe our only relief can come from the creek.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Menden Hall Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/50th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 17, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 30, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
