do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rogue River  
a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The point of diversion is to be located 35 ft. South and 260 ft. East  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
from the Northwest corner of Section 19, Township 34 South, Range 7 West  
Willamete Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon  
(Public Land Survey Corner)  
(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the Northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A one-horsepower jet-type pump is proposed for installation at the property's store-house with the water pick-up jet to be in the Rogue River at a point 320 feet from the pump - requiring a vertical lift of 55 feet. The proposed system will be hooked into an existing underground sprinkler system that is inadequately supplied by a small spring. The size of the two pipes required for a jet-pump system will be determined by a water-system specialist but probably will be 1 1/4 and 3/4 - inch respectively. If the jet pump proves inadequate a submersible pump (at the River) will be substituted.

7. Construction work will begin on or before September 15, 1978

8. Construction work will be completed on or before October 30, 1978


9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before October 30, 1978

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### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Rogue River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for one family and irrigation being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.015 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 5, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 6, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
