make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed + Little River

....., a tributary of North Umpqua

2. The point of diversion is to be located 7 ft. N (N. or S.) and 2 ft. E (E. or W.)  
from the SW corner of Site #1 (Public Land Survey Corner)

#1. small creek coming from mountain behind our home which runs all year - Has been used for domestic water at this location for over 25 years.

Little River, as shown on map which accompanies application being within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 12 Tp. 27 S R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of Douglas

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.275 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Little River and an unnamed creek.

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The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for one family and irrigation: being 0.27 c.f.s. from Little River for irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed creek for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 19, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 21, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
