- a. ALL WORK TO BE DONE WITHIN LOT 7, BLOCK 1, SPRING LAKE ESTATES ADDITION NO. 2, MARION COUNTY.
- b. EXCAVATE SMALL OFF-CHANNEL RESERVOIR AS SHOWN ON PLANS.
- c. RE-ALIGN EXISTING CREEK WITHIN PROPERTY AS SHOWN; OTHER DRAINAGEWAYS TO REMAIN UNDISTURBED.
- d. CONSTRUCT SMALL (9" HIGH) CHECK STRUCTURE OF CONCRETE IN UPPER CHANNEL
- e. DO MINOR DIKING TO CONTAIN WATER IN CHANNEL AND IN RESERVOIR.
- f. INSTALL 4" ϕ SUPPLY LINE FROM CHANNEL ABOVE CHECK STRUCTURE INTO POND; SCREEN 4" ϕ INTAKE
- g. INSTALL 12" ϕ CMP OVERFLOW PIPE TO MAINTAIN RESERVOIR FULL SUPPLY LEVEL AT ELEV. 105.

8. Construction work will be completed on or before OCT. 1979

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before NOV. 1979

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Remarks: 1) RESERVOIR IS OFF CHANNEL AND NOT SUBJECT TO CREEK FLOOD FLOODS; ALMOST ALL STORAGE IS TO BE HELD BELOW EXISTING GROUND LEVEL.

2) APPROPRIATION IS NOT FOR A CONSUMPTIVE USE; WATER TO BE CIRCULATED THROUGH RESERVOIR TO MAINTAIN WATER QUALITY, & THEN IT WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY RETURNED TO CREEK THROUGH OVERFLOW PIPE

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-58014, permit No. R-7770.

The use to which this water is to be applied is recreation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 20, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
