1. The source of the proposed appropriation is CLEAR CR, a tributary of PINE CR

2. The point of diversion is to be located 20 ft. N. and 1500 ft. E. from the Center 1/4 corner of Sec. 30, T. 7S., R. 46E. W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 7S., R. 46E., W. M., in the county of Baker

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This irrigation system is controlled by one cement headgate with one opening controlled by a screw valve. The 6 acres are flood irrigated with plastic dams.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clear Creek

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The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 3, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
