Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1500 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Bull Run River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Bull Run #2 hydroelectric installation for generation of 17,045 theoretical horsepower.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated. In conformity with an order of the Water Policy Review Board entered October 26, 1978, and action of the Portland City Council taken September 13, 1978, this permit is issued subject to the following provision:

Except as necessary to protect the quantity and quality of the City's water supply, fluctuation of the reservoir shall be limited to elevation 858 and the spillway crest.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 7, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1980 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
