Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring, unnamed stream, and Sixes River; being 0.005 c.f.s. from the spring for domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area, and 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available supply of water from the stream to be made up by diversion of water from Sixes River for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 13, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19...80

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19...81
