make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed drainway, a tributary of Sagebrush Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 840 ft. S and 280 ft. E from the NW corner of Section 27 (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Public Land Survey Corner)



Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.28 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed drainage

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation the right allowed may in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 9, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 20, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
