This instrument was first received in the office of the Water Resources Director at Salem, Oregon, on the 12th day of January, 19 78, at 8 o'clock A.M.

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4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 300 gallons/day of cubic feet per second domestic water per house. There will be 4 houses.
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)
There will also be an additional 200 gal/day used for lawns & gardens.

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is drinking water, irrigating gardens & lawns.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply diich or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

There will be two separate systems. Each system will have a 1 hp jet pump delivering water through a 1 1/2" PVC pipe which will be buried 24 inches underground. The pumps will be above the 64 flood level housed in a small house. The intakes will be foot valves.

One system will be 1700 feet to a 1200 gal tank ^(Line 1). The other system will be 2600 feet to another 1200 gallon tank ^(Line 2). Each tank will serve two houses.

Line 1 will serve a house on Lot 3 BL1 and one house on Lot 2 BL1 of Roseburg Home Orchard Tracts Plat A.

Line 2 will serve a house on on Lot 1 BL1 and one house on Lot 8 BL1 of Roseburg Home Orchard Tracts Plat M. The houses are not built at this time.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Umpqua River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for four families, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and garden for each.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 12, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 20, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981
