Pumps are the same as those approved under Permit # 36729. Instream impoundment is 4' high at concrete abutments with 10' STREAM BANKS. Flashboards will be 3.5 ft high with 3 sections 8' wide. Total width of dam is 24'

7. Construction work will begin on or before 3-30-77

8. Construction work will be completed on or before complete

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Oct. 15, 1978

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 34.8 acre feet of stored water only... measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-55305, permit No. R-7807.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 22, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
