2. The point of diversion is to be located 640 ft. S. and 1520 ft. N. within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 (E. or W.) from the NE 1/4 corner of Sec. 32, T. 12 S. R. 32 E. Div. Pt. # 2. (Public Land Survey Corner) 200' N. & 2740' E. from the W 1/2 cor. Sec. 5, T. 13 S. R. 32 E. in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Div. Pt. # 3, 1120' N. & 1720' E. from the SW cor. Sec. 5, T. 13 S. R. 32 E. within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Div. Pt. # 4, 150' S. & 1120' E. from the NW cor. of Sec. 8, T. 13 S. R. 32 E. in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 being within the 1/4 of the 1/4 of Div. Pt. # 5, 1720' E. from W 1/2 cor Sec. 5, T. 13 S. R. 32 E. in SE NW Sec 5 Res. B Sec. Tp. R. W. M., in the county of Grant (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6.59 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring and Reservoir A, an unnamed gulch and Reservoir B, both to be constructed under application No.

R-57901, permit No. R-7808, and Grub Creek; being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area, and 0.54 c.f.s for irrigation from the spring and Reservoir A, 0.55 c.f.s. from an unnamed gulch and Reservoir B with any deficiency in the available supply to be made up by diversion of water from the spring for irrigation, and 5.48 c.f.s. from Grub Creek for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 7, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
